Outdoor Play

A major aspect of EYFS curriculum, is the emphasis on outdoor play. We go outside on a daily basis, so we ask that you ensure your child brings appropriate clothing to school especially during sports and swimming lessons. We recommend that this is applied once before school and that your child knows how to do it themselves, so that they can apply it again at lunch time. Please do note the swimming and sports timings.
